Knox County COVOD-19 Update

According to the Knox County Health Department, as of Sunday, October 18th, Knox County has had 11,589 confirmed cases of COVID-19, 427 of which have required hospitalization at some point during their illness. Throughout the county, 64 patients are currently hospitalized with COVID-19 and the total number of deaths has now increased to 95. Of the 11,589 confirmed cases, 10,843 of the patients have fully recovered. There are currently 1,208 active cases in Knox County, up from 1,039 last week. The 1,039 active cases reported include 557 probable cases, leaving 482 confirmed actives cases. As always, this information is given to help you best determine whether it is best for you to venture out to church or elsewhere or to stay at home.
